

Sample Discussion Questions

Question #1	<p>What are we supposed to know while here on Earth?</p> <p>Have you ever thought about who made you? What did you think was the answer before watching this video?</p> <p>Who made us?</p> <p>Do you feel like God is with you or like you are alone? Explain.</p> <p>What do you think will help you to know God is with you?</p> <p>When will we be with God?</p> <p>What is Jesus called? (way, truth, life) Why is he called those three things?</p>
Question #2	<p>Have you ever experienced falling in love? What was that like for you? Did you want to tell everyone about it or keep it to yourself?</p> <p>What word do we use to describe God? Why?</p> <p>What word would YOU use to describe God? Why?</p>
Question #3	<p>What have you tried to do to satisfy yourself? Food, relationships, TV binge-watching...?</p> <p>What do you want? Why?</p> <p>What will satisfy that longing in your heart? Do you believe this? Why or why not?</p>
Question #4	<p>There are two different groups of things in the world. What are they?</p> <p>Which group of things do we naturally prefer? Which group connects us to God?</p> <p>What is one fact we can use to prove God is real?</p>
Question #5	<p>What is one reason why people say God is not real?</p> <p>Have you ever experienced anyone telling you God is not real? What did you do in that situation?</p> <p>If that situation happened again (someone telling you God is not real), what would you do differently?</p>

	<p>Do you understand why that person does not believe God is real? What would change for that person if he or she believed God is real?</p>
<p>Question #6</p>	<p>Can we understand God? Why not?</p> <p>How can we try to understand God?</p> <p>What is one example of what people do to try to understand Him?</p> <p>How have you tried to understand God?</p>
<p>Question #7</p>	<p>Have you ever experienced a relationship? What helps that relationship to be strong or to work well?</p> <p>Why did God want to send Jesus, His Son, to us?</p> <p>How did God try to help us understand Him better?</p> <p>What does the word “revelation” mean? How is it different from Revelation?</p>
<p>Question #8</p>	<p>How did God appear in the Old Testament?</p> <p>Who were the different people God revealed Himself to?</p> <p>What did God do with each person or group of people? (Noah, Moses, Israelites...)</p> <p>What did God do with Noah?</p> <p>What did God tell Moses?</p> <p>How did Moses help God?</p> <p>What did God give Moses?</p> <p>Who are God’s chosen people?</p>
<p>Question #9</p>	<p>How can we see God? How did God help us see Him?</p> <p>How does Jesus help us?</p> <p>In your life, what has Jesus done for you?</p>

<p>Question #10</p>	<p>Will God ever share any information now that would not be the same as what Jesus taught us in the New Testament?</p> <p>What are two of the Marian apparitions? Name two places where Mary appeared.</p> <p>Did Mary say something that was different from what Jesus said?</p> <p>Do we HAVE to believe private revelations to individuals? Name something that Jesus taught in the New Testament.</p> <p>Name something you KNOW God would NEVER say.</p>
<p>Question #11</p>	<p>Who taught you your faith? Who taught you to believe in God?</p> <p>Name one thing you have taught someone.</p> <p>Think about your life. Who in your life needs you to teach them about your faith, about God?</p>
